When God Almighty Acts, the Holy One is Revealed Isaiah 41:13-20

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I. HISTORICAL BACKGROUND AND BIBLICAL CONTEXT A. Historical Background

Beginning with Genesis chapter 1, the Bible consistently highlights that God, along with The Word and the Holy Spirit, brought forth things unseen into reality, that is materially things that can be seen, touched, smelled and used. During the formation of the Earth, God spoke and brought forth the light to distinguish between Day and Night. In the same way, God spoke and **brought forth** the oceans, seas, lakes, rivers and the Continents and so on as described in Genesis chapter 1. Whatever God declared, it came into **existence.** Everything the Almighty God established "In the beginning," has continued to exist and will continue to exist regardless of what Man thinks, does and will do. The other major theme highlighted in the Bible is that starting with Adam and Eve, humans have continued to disobey God and suffer the consequences of their actions. However, the Almighty God who is loving, gracious and merciful initiated His Plan of Salvation based on a Covenant **Relationship** for sinners to be *reconciled* with Him *through* **the Redeemer** by Faith and Repentance. This shall hold true until the Second Coming of our Lord Jesus Christ!

B. Biblical Context

God's Plan of Salvation was *initiated* through Abraham (Genesis 12). We should take notice that <u>it was God who initiated it</u>. Also, God's Plan of Salvation included the *Divine Call, Command, Promise* and *Foretelling* as to *how* things will **come forth**. Let us examine verses Genesis 12, verses 1-4.

- a) <u>The Divine Call and Command</u>. God called Abram and commanded him saying, "go to the land I will show you."
- b) The Divine Promise and the Foretelling.
 - "I will make you into a great nation and I will bless you;
 - "I will make your name great and you will be a blessing;
 - "I will bless those who bless you and whoever curses you, I will curse;
 - "And all the peoples on earth will be **blessed** through you."

c) <u>Abram's Part</u>. Faith and Obedience. Abram *believed* God and *obeyed* His command by putting his Faith into action. Notice if Abram didn't obey and act on his faith, nothing could have happened!

This **Divine Pattern** continued to operate in God's Plan of Salvation to this day as manifested *through* the faithful and obedient Israelites (the Remnants) and the disciples of Christ.

II. THE LESSON: When God Almighty Acts, the Holy One is Revealed.

Verses 13 and 14 <u>contain</u> not only some of the many Awesome, Glorious and Majestic **Titles** of God, but also <u>reveal</u> His **Eternal Nature**, **Virtues and Promises**. In His <u>declarations</u>, we are supposed to <u>hear affirmations</u>, <u>understand divine confirmations</u> and <u>rejoice in the eternal assurance</u> God's Titles, Nature, Virtues and Promises <u>impart on</u> to us! Hallelujah! Recall that God's <u>declarations</u> bring forth all that He promised to manifest in the lives of those who <u>believe</u> and <u>obey</u> His Word! Furthermore, to those who are **called** by His Name, God will <u>impute divine virtues</u> which bring blessings and <u>empower</u> them to **bless others** in the context of advancing His Kingdom!

1. vv. 13-14. I AM THE LORD, YOUR GOD. YOUR REDEEMER.

God spoke through His servant Isaiah these words of encouragement to remind them *who and whose they are* while they were going through difficult times.

a) Verse 13. I AM THE LORD, YOUR GOD.

"For I am the LORD, <u>your</u> God, who takes hold of your right hand and says to you, '**Do not fear**." Notice God's <u>declarations</u> which <u>affirm</u> that He has <u>chosen</u> to be "**The LORD**" over <u>our</u> lives and <u>our</u> "God." **First of all, what a glorious** <u>undeserved</u> **privilege that is!** Let us examine verse 13 to receive all the blessings in it!

i. "I am the LORD, your God." During the time of Exodus, the Israelites have heard this declaration many times as God pronounced it over their lives. By declaring it, God made His desire and intention to become "the LORD" over their lives be known to them. "The LORD," as His Title, contains The Awesome Might, Limitless Authority and Power of God who created the Universe! God chose the Israelites to demonstrate His Lordship and governance over their lives so that they become "an example" to other people/nations whose gods were idols their own imagination and hands made. God's people, the Israelites of the OT and

Christians in the NT era, were supposed to be *distinguished* from other idols worshipping people because "The LORD" was/is their God!

- "Who takes hold of your right hand." Just imagine the God who created the Universe "holding your right hand" to guide you in His ways. To begin with, what is the eternal significance of God holding "your/my right hand?" At the minimum, (a) God's Hand holding yours and mine signifies The LORD has a claim over you and me as His chosen people. It communicates to us and other people we belong to God. (b) The Limitless Authority and Awesome Power of God's Hand holding your/my right hand assures us that no power on earth or in heaven can separate, snatch or harm us! (Ephesians 6:10-18; Colossians 1:15-33). Hallelujah!
- "Do Not Fear." Knowing everything that we know about "The LORD, our God," whom shall we fear? Fear negates Faith in the context of our relationship with "The LORD, our God." Fear, as part of our emotional pool of feeling, is healthy, natural and beneficial since it alerts us to imminent danger. It is natural for us to experience fear faced with dangerous situations. However, God wants us to exercise our faith in Him knowing and believing that He is holding our hands!

Just the fact that God <u>chose</u> us to be <u>His</u> people is enough to cause us to overflow with joy brimming with gratefulness! Understanding that the God who created the universe decided to be **The LORD** over our lives should give us all the **assurance** that we need to press forward with absolute confidence and joyful dedication! Even as we go through these tumultuous times, God says to us "**Do not Fear**" because "**I am The Lord**, your **God**!"

b) Verse 14. YOUR REDEEMER, THE HOLY ONE OF ISRAEL.

"Do Not be afraid, O worm Jacob, O little Israel, for I Myself will help you" declares the LORD, the "Redeemer, the Holy One of Israel." The phrase "O worm Jacob" and "O little Israel," are meant to emphasis how insignificant "Jacob" is in the scale of God's Creation. However, we should see ourselves how God sees us: as His Beloved Children, as part of His Kingdom and the Disciples of Christ. Left to our evil desires and schemes, we can become as worthless as a "worm" a meal to the birds and "little Israel" who forgot or rejected that he was divinely destined for greatness! Yet, The LORD says to him/the Israelites, "I Myself will help you" and declared that He will be their/our "Redeemer, the Holy One of Israel." Notice the prophetic language which is already realized in Jesus Christ! What a Message of Hope that was for the Israelites back then! It also became an affirmation and confirmation of the

message of Salvation for those of us who are redeemed by the Blood of Lamb of God!

2. vv. 15-16. You will Rejoice and Glory in the Holy One of Israel.

We need to understand that **The Holy One of Israel** referred in Isaiah is the **Lamb of God**, **The Redeemer**, **The Messiah** about whom God is **foretelling**. The language of the prophecy is filled with *metaphors* and *images/figurative speech* that the Israelites will immediately identify with. God says, He will make the Holy One of Israel, the Redeemer:

- a) "a **threshing sledge**, new and sharp, with many teeth." A **threshing sledge** is an agricultural tool used to separate grain from the straw after harvesting. It is a heavy wooden board with a jagged and rough surface designed to separate **the grain** from the plant stalk, allowing the grain to be easily **winnowed** (separated from the chaff).
- b) "you will winnow them." To "winnow" is to generate a strong current of air through a harvested crop to **blow away the chaff**.

Agriculture and livestock were the main economy in the old days. The Bible uses figurative speech using things, systems, equipment and methods commonly used everyday in livestock management, farming and trading as metaphors to effectively and vividly communicate **spiritual matters of eternal significance**. Jesus used the same technique when He used parables to help us understand the Significance of the Cross and the way things will shake out during His Second Coming (Matthew 24:1-51). When that time comes, "Do Not Fear." **Instead, you will rejoice and glory in the Holy One of Israel, your Redeemer!**

3. v. 17. The Holy One of Israel will Take Care of the Poor and Needy.

Both in the OT and the NT, the Bible is clear that God's chosen people must take care of "the poor and needy." The commandments were not optional for the Israelites then as they are not for us today (Deut. 24:14-15, 17-22; Psalm 113:1-9; Isaiah 10:1-4; Matthew 25:31-46). God always had and still has a way of taking care of the Poor and Needy. But woe to those who neglected to take care of the poor and needy while they had the opportunity and the resources to do it! In verse 17, God promised that He will take care of them: that He "will not forsake them." The way God is going to "take care of the poor and needy is two-fold. On the one hand, the Holy and Righteous One will judge those who disobeyed His commandments. On the other hand, He will renew, restore and refresh everything in such a manner that the whole world will know that only God could do such a thing!

4. vv. 18-20. The Holy One of Israel has Done This!

a) The Restoration of the Material World.

When God makes "rivers flow on barren heights and springs within the valleys." As a result,

- Barren lands and deserts shall be healed, restored, refreshed and renewed.
- Trees, Plants and Vegetation shall *spring up* and produce fruits in abundance. Deforestation will be reversed: deforested lands will be healed and restored to produce "cedars and the acacia, the myrtle and the olive." The wastelands shall be inhabited by forest, where "pines, the fir and the cypress abound together."
- God will *reverse* all the *damage done* by human **greed**, *reckless* **disregard** for nature and **lack of concern** for the welfare of the habitat.

"so that people may see and know, may consider and understand that the hand of the LORD has done this, the Holy One of Israel has created it."

b) The Spiritual Restoration and Rejuvenation!

- The down cast, the broken hearted and the spiritually dead shall be lifted up: they will be healed, restored and refreshed by the **Power of the Holy One of Israel, the Redeemer.**
- The blind shall receive their sight; the deaf shall hearing; the lame shall walk; the mute shall talk; the dead shall be resurrected.

When God Almighty Acted, the Holy One of Israel, the Lamb of God, The Redeemer was revealed in Bethlehem to fulfill the Prophecies. What God proclaimed materialized, "so that people may see and know, may consider and understand that the hand of the LORD has done this, the Holy One of Israel has created it."

III. CONCLUSION

When God Almighty Acts, The Holy One of Israel is Revealed!

So it shall be again at His Second Coming!
